

#### **CPSA Supervision Matrix**

# Please consider this Supervision Matrix for a Day 1 Practitioner

**Networks:** CPSA promote *Practitioners* to move away from lone practice and develop *Networks*. CPSA foresee this will be achieved through a JCCP portal of *Supervisors* in your geographical area. All JCCP Registrants will be required to demonstrate that they comply with the JCCP\CPSA Code of Practice. This will include the need to evidence that they demonstrate professional behaviours that accord with the CPSA and JCCP mission and purpose. The CPSA will be producing a *Professional Behaviours Course Curriculum* against which all Registrants must demonstrate compliance. *This* will also facilitate networking, and present an opportunity for non-clinicians to meet clinicians. CPSA recognise this is an evolutionary process and will take time to establish.

**Competence:** CPSA recognise competence as appropriate knowledge, skills and behaviours. **Practitioner** commitment to competence is career long and it is vital that all aspects of competence are maintained. CPSA believe this can only be achieved through appropriate **Supervision**. **Supervision** and team working is known to improve outcomes. **Supervision** is deemed mandatory by all the professional healthcare regulators and the CPSA/JCCP.

Supervision requirements: Supervision is central to patient safety and will also protect the practitioner. CPSA require all *Practitioners*, regardless of professional background to have a named *Supervisor*. Supervision is an essential part of best practice; underpinning professionalism. It is a key requirement of all registered practitioners to develop a local network of peers and supervisors to facilitate prompt, face-to-face supports and appraisal. The level and nature of *Supervision* varies according to the procedure risk, HEE level, background of *Practitioner* and the discretion of the *Supervisor*. Supervision will vary from *Direct Supervision* for the practitioners' first post-training procedures, Supervision immediately available on the premises, or Access to a Supervisor for: telephone advice, taking over complex cases and treating complications. Access to Supervisor in most cases must be prompt (however, with fillers it must be within 15 minutes). The NHS standard is within 30 minutes of the procedure taking place and we use this as a guide to inform practitioners of their responsibility to develop local networks. This it to prevent 'Ghost' supervision.

Through extensive stakeholder engagement, CPSA have tried to establish a proportionate **Supervision Matrix**, according to the risks. **Supervisors** will also help to develop **Practitioners** through Continual Professional Development (CPD). All Registrants are required to demonstrate that they have the requisite knowledge, skills and experience at the appropriate educational level that the JCCP has determined within its published education and training standards framework.

## **Professional Statutory Regulatory Body (PSRB)**

- The PSRBs regulate healthcare professionals (e.g. GMC, GDC, NMC, HCPC, GPhC etc.).
- Healthcare professionals who are regulated hold a license to practice. They are subject to sanctions or removal of the license if the Code of Practice is breached.
- Without a license to practice, these professionals are unable to continue in their professional capacity.
- The JCCP is able to freely share information about Practitioners to the PSRBs and vice-versa.

#### Supervision

• Weekly face-to-face appraisal with full discussion of all cases performed, any adverse incidents or complications, any near-misses, PROMS.

## Direct Access to Supervisor

• Supervisor is within the premises

#### Access to Supervisor

- Supervisor should be available for advice within 30 minutes of procedure and should be local. Local will
  vary in urban/rural areas but access to a local network is expected in all cases. Supervisors have an
  ethical and legal responsibility to those they supervise. For comparison NHS standards are that
  supervisors are able to be present within 30 mins and/or reside within 20 miles. This is the CPSA
  recommendation.
- For **fillers** is it a requirement that supervisors **are able to be present within 15 minutes**, as prompt delivery of hylase (Level 7 prescriber) has a direct impact on the severity of injury in adverse incidents.
